



## Mountain Water Decaf NY MTGB

The Minas Gerais state is one of the most prolific coffee-producing areas in Brazil. Some of the highest quality specialty coffee is grown here, particularly in the Cerrado and Sul de Minas regions, where each harvest consistently yields high-scoring lots and impressive cup profiles. Although the

This sweet, chocolatey decaf was first naturally processed in Brazil, then decaffeinated with the Mountain Water process in Mexico. The coffee is soaked in pure water from the highest mountain in the region, Pico de Orizaba, to first extract caffeine and flavor compounds. Once the compound-rich water is filtered to remove 99.9% of the caffeine, it's reintroduced to the beans so they can reabsorb their flavors.

The entire process is chemical-free and produces decaf coffee that stays true to the characteristics developed from Cerrado and Sul de Minas' excellent terroir. A smooth fusion of chocolate and nuts highlighted by warm baking spices makes this a sweet Brazil Mountain Water Decaf that is a pleasure to drink any time of day.
