Coffee Background

The Windrush Estate, in Kiambu county, has about 163 hectares planted with coffee, and has been growing coffee since 1930. In 1971, it was acquired by Gatatha Farmers Company Ltd. This late crop coffee was grown in red volcanic soils rich in organic matter at 1730 meters above sea level.

Kenya green coffee beans are celebrated for bold, fruit-forward flavors that pack a punch in complex acidity. SL-28 and SL-34 are two of the most well-known varieties grown here, developed by Scott Agricultural Laboratories in the 1930s for drought resistance, exceptional cup quality, and large yield at high altitudes. After a coffee berry disease (CBD) epidemic in 1968, the CBD-immune Ruiru-11 variety was developed and quickly adopted throughout the country.
