Coffee Background

Grown at the high elevations of Finca La Bastilla in Nicaragua's renowned Jinotega region, this exceptional micro-lot showcases the distinctive Margogype variety, often referred to as the "Elephant Bean" because of its unusually large cherry and bean size. Hand-picked at peak ripeness and carefully washed at La Bastilla's on-site mill, this coffee earned an impressive cup score of 88 points. The result is a refined and complex profile featuring notes of dark chocolate, caramel, hazelnut, dried plum, and pomegranate.

Maragogype is a rare mutation of the Typica variety that was first discovered in Brazil and has become famous for producing some of the largest coffee beans in the world. While yield can be lower than other cultivars, the variety is prized for its unique cup quality, elegant body, and distinctive flavor complexity.

When grown at high elevations and carefully processed, Maragogype develops a refined sweetness and layered fruit character.
